I think I may be exempt... what evidence do I need to provide?

You can only get free NHS dental treatment if you:	The proof you need to provide us with:
Are included in the award of someone getting: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Income support Income-based Jobseekers Allowance Income-related Employment and Support Allowance 	Photocopy of your entitlement letter from your Jobcentre Plus office (please provide all pages of this document, not just the first page)
Are included in the award of someone getting Pension Credit Guarantee Credit	Photocopy of your award notice from the Pension Centre
Are included in an award of Tax Credits and meet the qualifying conditions	Photocopy of your valid NHS Tax Credit Exemption Certificate
Are named on a valid HC2 or HC3* certificate	Photocopy of your certificate. *Please note that a valid HC3 certificate may entitle you to treatment at a reduced charge, not free of charge
Are under 18 years old	Photocopy of any official Government document showing your name and date of birth, such as your certificate, NHS medical card or passport
Are aged 18 and in full time education	Photocopy of official document showing your name and date of birth (see above) and proof that you are a full-time student
Are pregnant or have had a baby in the 12 months before treatment starts	Photocopy of your MatB1 certificate, NHS maternity exemption certificate, notification of birth form, birth certificate or stillbirth certificate
